






REGISTRATION

Licenses:

Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

Deadline:

The deadline for registration is 10 days before the 1st day of event at 11:59 PM GMT +0: July 9th, 2024.

Quota:

Registration of Team Officials: Member Federations may register, within statutory deadlines, Team Officials for one of the following roles:

- (a) One (1) Team Manager
- (b) Number of coaches per discipline:
 - (ii) EYC Lead: 3 Coaches
 - (iii) EYC Speed: 2 Coaches
- (c) Up to three (3) qualified medical or para-medical personnel.

Registration of Competitors: Member Federations may register as competitors:

(a) Per Category

(i) U16 and U18















(i) up to three (3) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline

(ii) up to two (2) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline for the top ten ranked federations (ranking calculation like it is set out in IFSC-Europe Rules Art. 2.3)

(ii) U20

(i) up to two (2) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline

(ii) up to two (2) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline for the top ten ranked federations (ranking calculation like it is set out in IFSC-E rules Art. 2.3)

(b) the host federation shall be entitled to register an additional two (2) competitors in each Category for each relevant discipline.

(c) up to two (2) competitors for each Category and gender in each relevant discipline for the African council

Competition Format: according to the current IFSC Europe Rules

Registration Fees:

30 € for each competitor. The Registration fee will be invoiced by the IFSC Europe to the National Federations. No cash-payments will be accepted on site.

It is necessary for all team managers to show the passports or ID-cards (or copies) of their competitors for on-site registration on Thursday 18th July 2024.

How to get there:

By plane

Direct plane flights to Žilina operate locally only, therefore we recommend using international airports, the closest international airports are: Bratislava (SVK), Kosice (SVK), Wien (AUT), Budapest (HUN), Prague (CZE), Krakow (POL).

















By train

The main railway station in Žilina is one of the most important railway stations in Slovakia. There are direct trains from several European cities, including Bratislava (SVK), Vienna (AUT) or Prague (CZE). There is also a possibility to arrive from Budapest (HUN) and change trains in Bratislava or Vienna. You can find your train options at the national railway's website: https://www.zsr.sk/en/

By car

Žilina is located right on the main highway D1 (E58) and is easily accessed by car. It takes about 2 hours from Bratislava, 3 hours from Vienna, 3 hours from Košice, 3 hours from Krakow, 4 hours from Budapest, 4,5 hours from Prague.

ACCOMODATION

The hotel is located in the historic center of Žilina and provides exclusive spaces with a unique design. Hotel guests have the opportunity to use the services of the hotel's Relax Center free of charge, which include a jacuzzi, a Finnish sauna, a hydromassage shower and a stationary bicycle. In addition to the comfortable equipment of the center, you can also enjoy massages or exclusive cosmetic procedures of the Sothys Paris brand.

Hotel Galileo

Located within the walking distance of the venue (18 min.). A bike sharing stand is only a couple of minutes from the hotel.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

No temporary infrastructure needs to be built to host the EYC Žilina 2024. Only existing walls and buildings will be used to facilitate the event. At the venue:
